Our History

The Janazah Committee of Hampton Roads (JCHR) was established in October 2021 following a gathering at Lakewood Park in Norfolk titled *Breaking Down the Barriers*.

This initiative aimed to unite individuals from various masajid and Islamic centers, as well as those who have become disconnected from these institutions, fostering a community of mutual support and care. One of the primary concerns raised was the need for organized care for the deceased, which remains our central mission today.

Our Purpose

We are committed to organizing and facilitating essential services following the passing of any Muslim—male or female—in the Hampton Roads area. Our responsibilities include preparing shroud packages, maintaining supply cabinets within masajid, coordinating volunteers to assist in the preparation of the deceased for burial, and ensuring that Islamic leaders, such as imams, council members, and active community members, have access to this information.

We also offer seminars and workshops to train men and women in the proper procedures for washing and shrouding the deceased.

In the Event of Death: Steps To Follow

O 1. Get a Death Certificate

- **A.**) If death occurs in a Hospital or Nursing Home this will be provided.
- **B.**) If death occurs at home and Hospice or a Health Care provider is involved, contact the Caregiver to certify the death and provide the Certificate.
- **C.**) If no Health Care or Hospice service is involved, call the Police.

O 2.Call a Facilitator of Burial Arrangements.

This individual will obtain necessary information from you and will then contact the Funeral Home and the Coordinator of a team who will prepare the deceased for burial.
